

Town of Bristol Town Board Meeting Minutes January 14, 2019

Chairman Derr called the meeting to order at 5pm. All members present.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Minutes of the previous meetings were read. Willison moved to approve, Grove seconded, motion carried.

Public comment: Doug Tjugum asked about the property tax increase. Board/Clerk explained that increase in 2018 was due to new construction and debt service. Tjugum also thanked the Town for posting agendas for drainage board meetings.

Bob Wipperfurth, Village of Windsor President:

President Wipperfurth stopped by to say hello and introduce himself. He mentioned that the Dane County Cities and Villages Association would like to hold a joint meeting with the Dane County Towns Association re: roads, among other things. He also just wanted to keep open lines of communication between Windsor and Bristol for anything that may come up, including possibly pursuing a joint ag enterprise area.

Review and consider a request for a second driveway at 6889 Moonlight Circle:

Homeowner didn't appear at meeting, Board doesn't have enough information to make a decision. Tabled until another meeting.

Review and consider a request for funding for an event in Fox Hill/Drumlin Creek:

Sue Bengsch approached the Board and explained the purpose of the event and what it all entails. Asked the Board to provide \$50-75 in reimbursement of costs. Grove made the motion to donate \$50, Willison seconded, motion carried.

Review and consider a bartenders license for Alexis Richards at Midway Roadhouse:

Clerk explained to the Board that the applicant admitted to a DUI offense 1.5 years ago on her application. There was discussion as to whether one issue was reason to deny a license. Decided that this was likely a one time mistake, not a pattern of misbehavior. Willison made the motion to approve the license, Grove seconded, motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer's Report was presented. Grove made the motion to approve, Willison seconded, motion carried. Willison made the motion to audit and pay bills, Grove seconded, motion carried.

Set future meetings and agendas:

If necessary, the Plan Commission will hold their monthly meeting on February 4th at 5:30pm. The next Parks & Rec Committee will likely not meet again until March. The Town Board will hold their monthly meeting on February 11th at 5pm.

Grove made the motion to adjourn, Willison seconded. Motion carried and meeting ended at 6:28pm.
